SCC Meeting – March 27, 2008**

Trust Lands Progress Report 2007-2008

- Successes with Read180 Scores
  - Lexile Scores increased from 754 to 901
  - Reading Aloud Rate (non-stuttering) increased from 130.7 to 145.6
  - Word Exposure increased from 626 to 21, 485
  - Word Accuracy (not making mistakes when they read) increased from 94.9 to 97.9
  - Books read this year were 18 on average, up from 8 the year before
  - General self perception increased from 3.7 to 4.5
  - Progress, self evaluated, increased from 34.8 to 39.7
  - Observational Comparison (comparing themselves to others) increased from 17.7 to 22
  - Social feedback (what others say to them) increased from 29 to 35.4
  - Psych states (I feel good when I read) rose from 25.4 to 29.1

Paula Fugal made a note that students not making progress should be tagged to go to Achievement Center next year for the Read 180 program.

- Plato – we funded 2 licenses, used by our resource student population and remedial help for At-Risk students.
- MyAccess Data
  - Last year, 60% of kids were scoring in 4-5 range, this year, 75% are scoring in 4-5 range.
  - CRTs are up to 94%
  - In comparison to District, our school is 2<sup>nd</sup> highest in number of submissions, and tied in proficiency.
  - Holistic Scores increased from 3.2 to 4
  - Focus and Meaning Scores increased from 3.7 to 4.1
  - Content and Development Scores increased from 3.4 to 3.7
  - Organization Scores increased from 3.3 to 3.7
  - Language Use, Voice and Style increased from 3.8 to 4
  - Mechanics and Conventions Scores increased from 3.5 to 3.8
- Achievement Center – Term 3 GPAs were reviewed and compared to Semester 1 GPAs, as we see continued success for students involved in AC.
- Math Tutoring – GPAs increased from 1.0 to 2.0 (Term 2 – Term 3)
- Professional Development – Nuts and Bolts Symposium discussed
